

Tarentum Borough is accepting applications for Borough Manager. Located in Allegheny County, 22 miles northeast of Pittsburgh, Tarentum is home to approximately 4,500 residents. The Borough has a police chief, 8 unionized police officers, 3 part-time officers, 7 unionized employees of the street department, a supervisor of public works, a water utility with 6 unionized employees, and electrical distribution company, 2 office staff members, and a code enforcement officer. This 1.39 square mile town oversees a marina, 34 boat dock leases, 20 miles of state and local roadways, as well as a park. The Borough's general operating budget is approximately 8 million dollars. The Borough functions under PA Borough Code with a mayor and 7 council positions. Council meets monthly. Applicants must have a BA or BS degree (preferably in Finance or Business Administration) and a minimum of 5 years experience in all aspects of municipal operations, including labor negotiations as well as grant writing. The Borough participates in various inter-governmental agencies, including but not limited to PennDOT, Allegheny Valley North Council of Governments, and Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs.
