AN ORDINANCE REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLES GENERALLY AND ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough, as is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The following intersections are established as stop intersections and official stop signs shall be erected (or ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second named street (the intersection or through street on the first named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first named street or stop sign, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the second named or intersecting street or through street until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall upon conviction be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars and costs.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
