DePuy Sworn in as PSAB President

Whitehall Borough Councilwoman looks toward future



Harrisburg, PA – Kathy N. DePuy, a member of the Whitehall Borough Council in Allegheny County, was sworn in as the president of the Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs (PSAB) at its 102nd annual conference in Hershey.

DePuy has served on the Whitehall Borough Council since 1990 and is president of the Allegheny County Boroughs Association. She previously served as first and second vice presidents for PSAB and was appointed in 2011 to serve on the board of directors of the Chrostwaite Institute. The Institute's activities are dedicated to improving areas such as government efficiency, investment in core communities, fiscal stability, transportation, water infrastructure, community and economic development.
