

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VI, SNOW AND ICE  
EMERGENCIES, OF THE CODE OF  
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH**

**Borough Council hereby enacts:**

**Section 1.** “Reserving parking spaces during periods of snow” is hereby enacted and added to the Code of ordinances of the Borough as follows:

- A. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person from December 1<sup>st</sup> of any year and continuing until March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year to place or cause to be placed any item, whatsoever, for the purpose of reserving parking spaces on any street in the borough during any periods of precipitation, whether or not a snow emergency has been declared.

**Section 2.** All other Ordinances and parts of other Ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
